Join us on Christmas Eve for Worship and a Live Nativity. The Live Nativity, with manger animals to pet and enjoy, runs from 3:30 - 7:30 pm on Christmas Eve. Christmas Pageant Worship with the children's pageant begins at 4:00 pm and Christmas Candlelight Worship with the angelic music of harp and flute begins at 6:00 pm. The harp and flute will play an extended prelude beginning at 5:45 pm, so come early to enjoy their celestial music!

This Sunday, the day after Christmas, we will continue our Christmas celebration. It will be **Pastor Peggy's last Sunday** with us, so she is bringing the Morning Message. Come to celebrate Christ's birth and to



COVID Safety: Current Procedures

Masks are required for all people in our building on Sunday mornings, regardless of vaccination status.
